The Newton Research Collaboration Programme is a component of the UK Newton Fund, which aims to develop science and innovation partnerships to promote the economic development and social welfare of developing countries.

Funds

Travel and Subsistence Costs for international exchanges between **Engineering researchers** in the UK and their counterparts in selected Newton Fund Partner Countries.

Length

Exchanges can last from three months up to a year.

Support available

Awards provide funding at a flat rate of £2,000 per month of exchange visit (up to £24,000 for 12 months' total exchange), regardless of the direction of travel or whether the exchange is one- or two-way.
